1st Responders Camp 2026

July 6 - 10

The Learning Jet will be hosting a 1st Responder Camp **July 6-10, 2026**. **This day camp is for students 15 – 20 years old** who have an interest in a career as a first responder. The first responder is a trained individual who arrives first to assist or resolve emergencies. First responders are typically law enforcement officers, firefighters, paramedics, military and emergency medical technicians.

The camp, which is free of charge, will be limited to thirty (30) students. The group will be selected by a committee from The Learning Jet. The camp will be held each day from 8:30am – 4:00pm and students are required to attend all five days. Many of the activities will take place at The Learning Jet facility at the Downtown St. Paul Airport, and other activities will be held off site.

During the week, the students will have the opportunity to meet and work with members of the St. Paul Police and Fire Departments, the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office and Water Patrol, Metropolitan Airports Commission Fire & Police Departments, the Minnesota State Patrol, Minnesota Air Rescue Team (MART) and Sun Country Airlines.

Each agency will discuss career opportunities, give a tour of their facilities and explain about the equipment that each department uses. The students will get appropriate firsthand experience with some equipment.

The MSP Airport Fire Department will provide a tour of their facility, demonstrate firefighting on aircraft and give a presentation on career opportunities as an airport fire fighter.

The St. Paul Police Department will be discussing the opportunities available within the department. There will be demonstrations including crisis negotiation, SWAT training, the bomb squad, hostage negotiations and a visit to their training facility.

The St. Paul Fire Department will provide a tour of their training facility in the Midway area of St. Paul. They will be demonstrating firefighting techniques, and rescue procedures from buildings and vehicles and the students will be given the opportunity to handle some of the equipment used in the performance of their jobs. Students will have the opportunity to talk with a 911 dispatcher and will be instructed in basic first aid and get certified in CPR.

The Minnesota State Patrol along with the Minnesota Air Rescue Team (MART) will be demonstrating air-rescue techniques.

Sun Country Airlines will conduct a tour of their maintenance facilities and make a presentation on careers in aviation.

The Ramsey County Sheriff's Water Patrol will be having the students spending half a day learning water rescue, watercraft operation and safety.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR MINOR PARTICIPANTS

READ BEFORE SIGNING

IN CONSIDERATION OF my child/ward being allowed to participate in any way in The Learning Jet related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges that,

The risks of injury and illness (ex: communicable diseases such as MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19) to my child from the activities involved in these programs are significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce these risks, the risks of serious injury and illness do exist; and,

1. FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE AND CHILD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation; and,
2. I willingly agree to comply with the program's stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child's

readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove my child from the participation and bring such attention of the nearest official immediately; and,

3. I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS The Learning Jet, its directors, officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event("Releasees"), WITH RESPECTTO ANY AND ALL INJURY, ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property incident to my child's involvement or participation in these programs, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I, for myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS all the above Releasees from any and all liabilities incident to my involvement or participation in these programs, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. I, the parent/guardian, assert that I have explained to my child/ward: the risks of the activity, his/her responsibilities for adhering to the rules and regulations, and that my child/ward understands this agreement.
6. I, the parent/guardian, understand that my child may be photographed, or video recorded during camp activities and these images may appear.
7. I, the parent/guardian, understand that my child will not be released from the camp during any day without a written, sign permission slip by the parent/guardian if the camper is under 18 years of age.
8. **I, FOR MYSELF, MY SPOUSE, AND CHILD/WARD, HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTANDITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.**
