1st Responders Camp - 2024

The Learning Jet will be hosting the 1st Responders Camp **June 24-28, 2024**. The camp is for high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors (ages 16 – 18) who have an interest in a career as a first responder. A first responder is a person with specialized training who is among the first to arrive and provide assistance or incident resolution at the scene of an emergency. First responders typically include law enforcement officers, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, and firefighters.

The camp, which is free of charge, will be limited to twenty-four (24) students. The group will be selected by a committee from The Learning Jet. The camp will be held each day from 8:30 am – 3:30 pm, students are expected to attend all five days. Many of the activities will take place at The Learning Jet facility at the Downtown St. Paul Airport and other activities will be held off site.

During the week, the students will have the opportunity to meet and work with members of the St. Paul Police and Fire Departments, Ramsey County Sheriff's Office and Water Patrol, Metropolitan Airports Commission Fire and Police Departments, Minnesota State Patrol, Minnesota Air Rescue Team, Life Link III, and a demonstration of basic first aid and CPR.

Each agency will discuss career opportunities, give a tour of their facilities and explain about the equipment that each department uses. The students will get appropriate hands-on experience with some equipment.

The MSP Airport Fire Department in conjunction with the Metropolitan Airports Commission will provide a tour of their facility, demonstrate fire fighting on aircraft, and give a presentation on career opportunities as an airport firefighter.

The MSP Airport Police Department will provide a demonstration of their K9 dogs, also known as airports dogs or explosive and drug detection dogs, who are specially trained canines that play a critical role in airport security. They will provide a tour of their facilities, as well as a visit to the medical unit at the airport.

The St. Paul Police Department will be discussing the many opportunities available within the department. There will be demonstrations including crisis negotiation and SWAT training.

The St. Paul Fire Department will provide a tour of their training facility in the Midway Area of St. Paul. They will be demonstrating firefighting techniques, rescue procedures from building and vehicles, and the students will be given an opportunity to handle some of the equipment used in the performance of their job.

Life Link III, in conjunction with St. Paul Fire, will bring a medivac helicopter, a flight nurse and an emergency medical technician to demonstrate their innovative bedside technology in an air medical setting. St. Paul Fire and paramedic team will provide additional equipment located onboard one of their ambulances to demonstrate their capabilities.

The Minnesota State Patrol along with the Minnesota Air Rescue Team will be demonstrating air rescue techniques.

The Ramsey County Sheriff's Water Patrol will offer an opportunity for students to spend a half day learning water rescue, watercraft operation, and water safety.

There will be training in basic first aid and CPR.

The Experimental Aircraft Association will provide Young Eagle flights for the participants.

I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Learning Jet, its directors, officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Releasees"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property incident to my child's involvement or participation in these programs, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
